2 Corinthians 11:3-4 **3** But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. **4** For if he who comes preaches another Jesus whom we have not preached, or if you receive a different spirit which you have not received, or a different gospel which you have not accepted—you may well put up with it!

## Five foundational ministries of Jesus! His Why statement!

Luke 4:16-21 (NKJV) **16** So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. **17** And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: **18** **“The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; 19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.”** **20** Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. **21** And He began to say to them, “Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing.”

### 1. Salvation

2 Corinthians 6:2 (NKJV) **2** For He says: “In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you.” Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.

2 Greek Words For Poor:

Pinnacle: The working poor-for daily sustenance

TooCos: The Poor who have no ability to work, the lame, blind, crippled, etc..

### 2. Inner Healing

Broken Hearted 2 words in the Greek:

Cardia: Its where we get the word cardiac

Sintreebow: To shatter or break completely

### 3. Freedom

Matthew 8:16-17 (NKJV) **16** When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with **a word**, and healed **all who were sick**, **17** that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: “He Himself took our infirmities And **bore** our sicknesses.”

### 4. Healing vs.18 “Recovery of sight to the blind.”

1 Peter 2:24 (NKJV) who Himself **bore** our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

Luke 5:23 (NKJV) Which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Rise up and walk'?

Hebrews 13:8 (AMP) Jesus Christ is [eternally changeless, always] the same yesterday and today and forever.

### **5. The Anointing of The Holy Spirit**

Acts 10:38 (NKJV) how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

John 1:33 (NKJV) I did not know Him, but He who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'Upon whom you see the Spirit descending, and remaining on Him, this is He who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.'
