Identity Check Up: I Am Forgiven

Romans 7:25 Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!

What did he deliver us from?

1. Debt of Sin

Romans 4:25 He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.

2. Devil

Colossians 2:15 And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.

3. Death

John 11:25 I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die

How are we to experience this deliverance in every day life?

Colossians 2:6-10 So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, ⁷rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness. ⁸See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ. ⁹For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, ¹⁰and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the head over every power and authority.

1. POSSESS YOUR DELIVERANCE

God's part is the promise...our part is the possession.

God has delivered you from the dominion of darkness, but you have to walk into your victory by faith!

Possession is through faith.

Hebrews 6:12 We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.

Romans 10:8 The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the message concerning faith that we proclaim

Faith: 1) believes 2) talks 3) walks

How has God provided deliverance from poverty?

He gives His promises...He speaks His Word...and we agree with His word with our hearts, with our mouths and with our actions (obedience). All of this is by faith.

2. PROTECT YOUR DELIVERANCE

Make no agreement, contract, treaty with your enemy!

Deuteronomy 7:2 When the Lord your God has delivered them over to you and you have defeated them, then you must destroy them totally. Make no treaty with them, and show them no mercy.

Satan is trying to outwit us, he has schemes against us (2 Corinthians 2:11), he seeks to devour us (1 Peter 5:8), he is trying to steal from us (John 10:10).

Ephesians 6:10 Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.

3. PROFESS YOUR DELIVERANCE

Psalms 107:2 (NASB) Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the adversary

Joshua 1:8 This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success.

Life Group Discussion

1. Is there any lack in your life due to deception, ignorance or apathy?
2. How do you counteract deception from creeping into your life?
3. How do you counteract ignorance from holding you back?
4. How do you counteract apathy from diminishing your life?
5. What area in your life is God teaching you to trust in Him?
6. How can we use the truths in this week's message to help us possess, protect and profess our deliverance?

Psalm 54:7

You have delivered me from all my troubles, and my eyes have looked in triumph on my foes.

Tuesday

1 John 5:4-5

Everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. Who is it that overcomes the world? Only the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.

Wednesday

2 Corinthians 1:10

He has delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us again. On him we have set our hope that he will continue to deliver us

Colossians 2:15

And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.

Friday

Luke 10:19

I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.
