Abundant Life Mindset: A Long Obedience in the Same Direction

Hebrews 11:8-10 By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going. By faith he made his home in the promised land like a stranger in a foreign country; he lived in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise. For he was looking forward to a city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God.

Hebrews 1:1-3 In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these late days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe. The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven.

Hebrews 8:6 But the ministry Jesus has received is as superior to theirs as the covenant of which he is mediator is superior to the old one, and it is founded on better promises.

## **Memory Verse:**

Hebrews 12:2 Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author & perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

## **Five Abundant Life Mindsets enabling a Long Obedience in the Same Direction.**

### **1. Author**

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!

Ephesians 2:8-10 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

### **2. Enlarged**

1 Thessalonians 5:24 The one who calls you is faithful and he will do it.

Philippians 3:12-14 Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already been made perfect, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me. I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

### **3. Gifts**

Isaiah 60:1 Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you.

The phrase “one another” is derived from the Greek word *allelon* which means “one another, each other; mutually, reciprocally.” Examples:

- Love one another (John 13:34) 16-times in New Testament
- Build up one another (Romans 14:19)
- Care for one another (1 Corinthians 12:25)
- Serve one another (Galatians 5:13)
- Pray for one another (James 5:16)

#### **4. Identity**

Psalm 139:13-14 For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully & wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.

Ephesians 4:23-24 ...to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

#### **5. Assurance**

Zephaniah 3:17 The Lord your God is with you, he is mighty to save. He will take great delight in you, he will quiet you with his love, he will rejoice over you with singing.

Philippians 1:6 ...being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
