What does it mean to be Charismatic?

## What does it mean to be charismatic?

Charismatic is a person who is Spirit Filled and Spirit Directed.

Sanctification is the process of becoming holy...set apart. That's why the personhood of God assigned to help us become like Jesus is called the HOLY Spirit. He helps make us holy.

The "gifts" of the Holy Spirit is the word charisma.

How is one baptized in the Holy Spirit?

Romans 12:6 We have different gifts according to the grace given us.

## 3 Baptisms:

We are baptized into the body of Christ.

1 Corinthians 12:13 For we were all baptized by one Spirit so as to form one body—whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink.

We are baptized in water.

Romans 6:4 We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

We are baptized with the Holy Spirit.

Acts 1:4-5, 8 On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. <sup>5</sup>For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

1 John 5:7-8 For there are three that testify: the Spirit, the water and the blood; and the three are in agreement.

## How to be filled with the Holy Spirit.

1. To be baptized into the body of Christ...you confess with your mouth Jesus is Lord.
2. To be baptized in water...you submerge yourself in a body of water as a public declaration of faith.
3. To be baptized in the Holy Spirit...you Ask, Seek and Knock...you receive by faith in prayer.

Luke 11:9-13 So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. <sup>10</sup>For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. <sup>11</sup>“Which of you fathers, if your son asks for a fish, will give him a snake instead? <sup>12</sup>Or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? <sup>13</sup>If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!”

### **Life Group Discussion**

1. Discuss this week's memory verse: Luke 11:13 “If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!”
2. Have you been baptized in the Holy Spirit?
3. Can you share how your experience is with the Holy Spirit? How does the Holy Spirit speak to you? How do you recharge yourself in the Holy Spirit?
