## Being saved does not destroy your will!

**Ephesians 4:27 (Amplified Bible)** Leave no [such] room or foothold for the devil [give no opportunity to him].

**A command to the Church, the believer, we can still yield to good or bad.**

### Are you growing in the Lord?

1. Feed your spirit to stay healthy
2. You must retain your food
3. Sickness is the result of nutrition not being retained

**1 John 2:14 (Amplified Bible)** I write to you, fathers, because you have come to know (recognize, be conscious of, and understand) Him Who [has existed] from the beginning. I write to you, young men, because you are strong and vigorous, and the Word of God is [always] abiding in you (in your hearts), and you have been victorious over the wicked one.

**Overcoming the wicked one is a result of the Word of God abiding in you!**

**Romans 6:16 (Amplified Bible)** Do you not know that if you continually surrender yourselves to anyone to do his will, you are the slaves of him whom you obey, whether that be to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience which leads to righteousness (right doing and right standing with God)?

**Law is for those who have no heart to obey. Those who have a heart to obey do so because they want to!**

**2 Peter 2:19 (New King James Version)** While they promise them liberty, they themselves are slaves of corruption; for by whom a person is overcome, by him also he is brought into bondage.

**1 John 2:15 (Amplified Bible)** Do not love or cherish the world or the things that are in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in him.

### The Food of The Flesh

**Galatians 5:19-21 (Amplified Bible)** Now the doings (practices) of the flesh are clear (obvious): they are immorality, impurity, indecency, 20 Idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, anger (ill temper), selfishness, divisions (dissensions), party spirit (factions, sects with peculiar opinions, heresies), 21 Envy, drunkenness, carousing, and the like. I warn you beforehand, just as I did previously, that those who do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

## How Does Bondage Begin?

### 1. Rebellion

**1 Samuel 15:23 (Amplified Bible)** For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as idolatry and teraphim (household good luck images). Because you have rejected the word of the Lord, He also has rejected you from being king.

**1 Samuel 16:14-15 (New Living Translation)** Now the Spirit of the Lord had left Saul, and the Lord sent a tormenting spirit that filled him with depression and fear. 15 Some of Saul's servants said to him, "A tormenting spirit from God is troubling you."

**With rebellion comes:** Hate, hate for parents, hate of authority, and of self. People hate themselves after hating others! Rebellion begins where love is absent!

### 2. Abuse of The Tongue

**Proverbs 13:3 (Amplified Bible)** He who guards his mouth keeps his life, but he who opens wide his lips comes to ruin.

**Proverbs 12:13 (Amplified Bible)** The wicked is [dangerously] snared by the transgression of his lips, but the [uncompromisingly] righteous shall come out of trouble.

### 3. A Critical Spirit

**Psalms 101:5 (Amplified Bible)** Whoever secretly slanders his neighbor, him will I cut off [from me]; he who has a haughty look and a proud and arrogant heart I cannot and I will not tolerate.

**2 Timothy 2:16-17 (Amplified Bible)** But avoid all empty (vain, useless, idle) talk, for it will lead people into more and more ungodliness. 17 And their teaching [will devour; it] will eat its way like cancer or spread like gangrene. So it is with Hymenaeus and Philetus,

### 4. Fear

**1 John 4:18 (New King James Version)** There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.

### 5. Laziness

**Proverbs 15:19 (New King James Version)** The way of the lazy man is like a hedge of thorns, But the way of the upright is a highway.
