12 Outlandish Sayings of Jesus

1. Give and you will be blessed.

Luke 6:38 Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.

Acts 20:35 ; 2 Corinthians 9:7-8, 10-11

2. Surrender your life and you will live.

Matthew 10:39 Whoever finds their life will lose it, and whoever loses their life for my sake will find it.

Matthew 16:26 ; Luke 14:33

3. Forgive and you will heal.

Matthew 6:12 Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who have sinned against us.

It is the forgiveness of sins that releases the soul from torment allowing healing to take place.

Acts 2:38 Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

4. Have faith in God.

Mark 11:22 Have faith in God

Mark 9:23 Everything is possible for one who believes.

Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

5. Prioritize the kingdom of God and your needs will be met.

Matthew 6:33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

6. Love your enemy.

Matthew 5:44 But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you.

Luke 6:35 But love your enemies, do good to them, and lend to them without expecting to get anything back. Then your reward will be great, and you will be children of the Most High, because he is kind to the ungrateful and wicked.

Romans 12:21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

7. Jesus is the only way to God.

John 14:6 Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

John 10:9 I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved.

Matthew 7:13-14 Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.

8. Don't worry.

Luke 12:22-26 Then Jesus said to his disciples: "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life.

Philippians 4:6-7 Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

9. Rejoice in trials.

Matthew 5:10-12 Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven,

James 1:2-4

10. Radically remove sin.

Matthew 18:8 If your hand or your foot causes you to stumble, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life maimed or crippled than to have two hands or two feet and be thrown into eternal fire.

11. Greatness is in serving, not being served.

Mark 10:43-45 Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.

Luke 22:26 ; Matthew 18:4

12. Money is not the answer.

Luke 12:15 Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; life does not consist in an abundance of possessions."

Matthew 6:24 You cannot serve both God and money.

Summary

1 Corinthians 2:14 (read 1 Cor. 2:6-16) The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit.
