Romans 8:13 For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live.

The Word of God

Romans 12:2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

The Body of Christ

Confess sins to one another, pray, healed.
Encouragement, support, extension of the Holy Spirit

James 5:16 Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

Ephesians 4:16 From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

Know your identity: I am in Christ

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!

Challenge: Study who you are in Christ. Memorize scripture about your identity.

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

1 Corinthians 15:22 For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive.

2 Corinthians 1:20 For no matter how many promises God has made, they are “Yes” in Christ. And so through him the “Amen” is spoken by us to the glory of God.

Know your authority: I am an ambassador of Christ

Luke 10:19 I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.

This authority is not for our sole personal benefit...if you think all of these promises of God is just for you personally you are missing the main point...you are called to be an ambassador for Christ and His mission. The authority He gives you is for your assignment to advance the kingdom of God.

Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses

2 Corinthians 5:20 We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us.

Challenge: Study what God has called you to do. Whatever God calls you to do, He empowers you to do.

Matthew 28:18-19 Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations

Ephesians 2:6 And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus

Know your inheritance: I am a co-heir with Christ

Romans 8:17 Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.
